I am sure we have all heard the dictum - today is the first day of the rest of your life. It contains a theological truth which is expressed right at the beginning of the Gospel for this weekend. Luke continues to show the reader that Jesus is the Messiah and that belief in Him is enough for Salvation; it is not dependent upon how long people have been practicing their religion. Notice how Jesus begins by having read scripture He looks at the people and says about Himself "today this is being fulfilled." In other words from this moment, if you believe, it will be the first day of the rest of your new life. No wonder there would be trouble.
