From the Parish Priest

I have been interested in the way in which the State is legislating more and more over concerning domestic behaviour matters which, in the past, was part of good Family life; there is proposed legislation concerning the food children eat - desperately trying to get children to eat fresh fruit and vegetables (Do you remember when you had to sit at the table and eat fresh cabbage, Swede and the dreaded Brussels sprouts as part of a proper well balanced meal)?! - desperately trying to get children to exercise each day (Do you remember a time when children had to be playing in the garden, going for walks with the Family and getting out in the fresh air)?! Now the latest move by the state is to push for legislation to get children to have less hours on their mobile phones, to stop them being used in the bedroom, to spend less time on laptops and computers and for parents and children to spend more time talking to each other. The intrusive nature of the State in these domestic matters signals a sad breakdown in the understanding of Family life and responsibility. I think that, as Christians, we recognize that there is a world of difference between a group of people who are just living together in a house and those who live together as a Family.
