One thing is certain. We are all sinners in need of God's forgiveness. The Gospel for today shows us three areas of our human life which can so easily lead to misuse and sin; gluttony, seeking power and thinking that we are invincible. To each of these temptations by the devil, Jesus gives an antidote and sharp rebuke to the devil. To the first, Jesus reminds the devil that it is not just food which gives life, but everlasting life is found in obedience to God and following his Words and commands. With the second temptation to exercise power in a material sense, Jesus tells the devil that the power to overcome and gain victory lies within the individual as the strength of God, which a person can exercise through determination and the following of conscience. The third temptation to think oneself to be invincible has led so many people to leave God and trust in their own way in life. To do this is a serious abrogation of humanity as made and sustained by the God who shows us the way to Salvation in his Son.
