On this Sunday, many churches will be celebrating the Divine Mercy given by God through Jesus to all who want to receive it. St Faustina Kowalska, a Polish nun, reported visions and visitations from Jesus and conversations with Him. He asked her to paint the vision of His Merciful Divinity being poured from His Sacred Heart and specifically asked for a feast of Divine Mercy to be established on the first Sunday after Easter so mankind would take refuge in Him. This weekend, there will be a picture from the shrine in Poland, which was given to the Parish by one of our congregation, in front of the altar. The Church officially approved the Devotion when Pope St John Paul II ordered that the Feast Day be incorporated into the Liturgical Calendar of the Church on the 22nd April 2001. Let us ask that by the prayers of St Faustina and through the Divine Mercy, members of all Faiths may live together in Peace. Fr Bruce
