


From the Parish Priest

All of the things which we gain through our short life here on earth are things which we cannot take with us when we die. We can do nothing about this. However, we can do something about our attitude to material goods. The readings for this weekend make some powerful suggestions. The first reading asks us to consider where and to whom we leave our possessions. Most of us would think about family or friends. The first reading suggests a powerful alternative; that we consider good causes, especially connected with the poor. The Gospel takes up this theme by reminding us that we should be good stewards of our possessions. The relative value of our possessions and our attachment to them is contrasted to the free gift of heaven which no money can buy.


