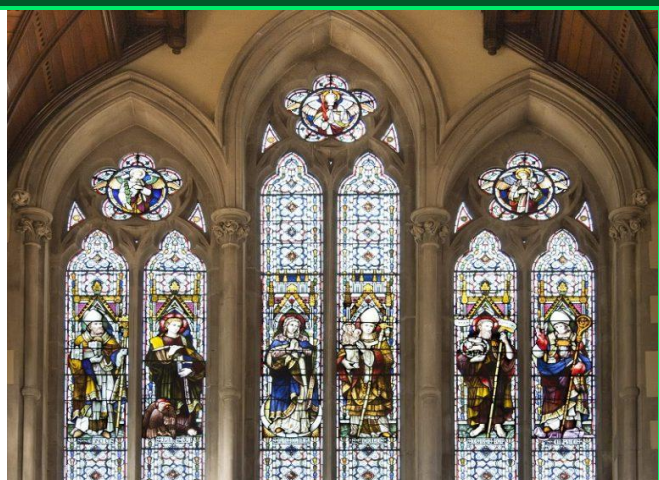

In his commentary on the year, Bishop Philip reflected that this year in our Diocese was punctuated with numerous milestones, including the 40th anniversary of the Bishop's ordination as a priest. It was also the Golden Jubilee of our special link with the Archdiocese of Bamenda in Cameroon.

"The many significant and special moments that have categorised this last year prompt us to honour the past, to embrace the present, and eagerly to anticipate the future," said the Bishop. The report covers many of the wide-ranging activities that took place across the Diocese between September 2023 and August 2024, including an update on the Closer to Christ Campaign, the work of our hospital and ethnic chaplaincies, the work of the Bishop's Spiritual Formation Team and a look at the pivotal role of Parish Finance Committees.
