## Luke 10:1-12,17-20

Our Gospel reading today speaks of amazing things.

Jesus sends out seventy-two of his followers ahead of him to every town and place. We hear that they return with joy, knowing that they've been able to heal the sick and that even the demons have become subject to them when they commanded them in the name of Jesus. But perhaps the most important message that they are to take with them is one of peace: "Peace be to this house!"

It's wonderful and beautiful that the Lord wishes to use us as his instruments to bring healing - at all levels -to those who are suffering. The goal of this healing, we might say, is peace. For the kingdom of God is a kingdom of peace (c.f. Rom 14:7 - "For the kingdom of God is not food and drink but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit".). This peace is not merely an absence of fighting or squabbles - although it is those things. It is "shalom"- a wholeness, completion or flourishing. The Compendium of the Social Doctrine of the Church has something beautiful to say about this peace: The promise of peace that runs through the entire Old Testament finds its fulfilment in the very person of Jesus. Peace, in fact, is the messianic attribute par excellence, in which all other beneficial effects of salvation are included. The Hebrew word "shalom" expresses this fullness of meaning in its etymological sense of "completeness"...The kingdom of the Messiah is precisely the kingdom of peace...Jesus "is our peace"
