John 3:13-17 Deacon Tony Darroch

We are often reminded that God does things differently to man. There are examples of this in both the Old and the New Testaments. For example, when the prophet Samuel was sent to Jesse's home to select one of his sons to succeed Saul as king, it wasn't the eldest warrior son chosen but the young musical shepherd who God anointed as the next king of Israel [1Samuel 16]. Likewise, at the time of Jesus, the Jewish leaders were hoping for a Messiah who would overthrow the Roman occupiers; instead, Jesus came speaking of peace, love and forgiveness.

In the Gospel Jesus tells us that no-one, but He has ever ascended into heaven. He then goes on to remind his audience that just as Moses lifted the serpent, so too would He be lifted up. Just as the people in the wilderness were given another chance to repent and seek forgiveness; so too would those who follow Jesus. Instead of a serpent, we would be given the Cross. The Jewish leaders at the time of Jesus saw the cross as the ultimate symbol of humiliation for Jesus. But remember God sees things differently to mankind, the serpent who killed was turned into an image which could save, the Cross of death and humiliation exchanged for the symbol of eternal salvation. But these gifts from God only apply when we have faith in the promises made in relation to them.
